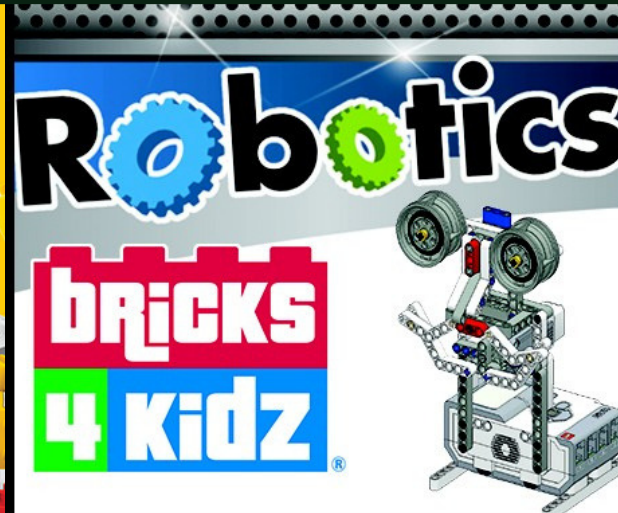


# LOWER SCHOOL AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES



## AFTER SCHOOL CARE
