

PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF

LOWER SCHOOL (EL - 7TH GRADE)



Drop-Off: Students should be dropped off in the lower lot, where faculty and staff will be on hand to assist.

Pick-Up: Parents should line up in the lower lot following the marked line on the pavement. Teachers will bring students to your car. For safety, remain in your vehicle and do not pull around other cars. Exit in a single file once directed to move forward.

K-5th grade: Car line begins at 2:45 pm. Middle School: Pick-up starts at 3:00 pm (second wave)

Students not picked up at dismissal will be taken to After School Care for drop-in services.

UPPER SCHOOL (8TH - 12TH GRADE)



Parents should enter the lot directly in front of the Basilica of Saint Andrew, following the green arrows. Once there, you may split into two lines, leaving space in the middle for cars to pass through and exit.

In the Upper School parking lot, only one line of cars may park along the curb. This ensures a clear exit lane for departing vehicles (marked in red).

Pick-Up: Upper school students who are **not** participating in after-school activities such as sports, piano lessons, or tutoring – are to be picked up by 3:00 pm.

STUDENT PARKING

Students who will be driving to school need to register their vehicle with the secretary. Students will park in the lower lot near the grotto. Seniors may park in the lot near the upper school gym.




